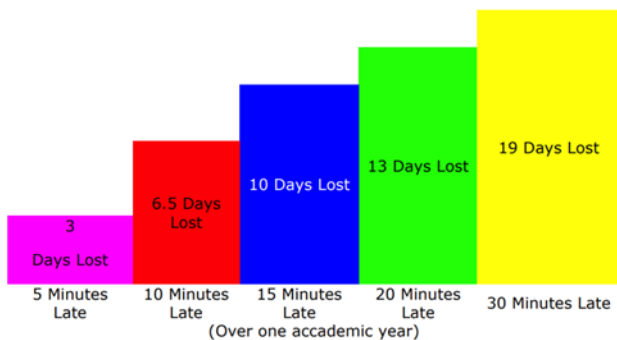
and due to staffing ratio's we have to limit places. Any children who just turn up and are not booked on will be turned away and parents contacted to collect them. We are also unable to amend or cancel any bookings that are out of the 7 days notice. Any changes you wish to make with the 7 days notice period can be done through the School Gateway app. Once you have booked your sessions, please double check all sessions are correct by clicking on manage bookings.

Late children:

Last week we had 80 children sign in late through the school office.

Every Minute Counts

If you arrive late to school everyday your learning begins to suffer. Below is a graph showing how being late to school everyday over a school year adds up to lost learning time.



When pupils arrive late, they miss out on essential instructions given at the beginning of the lesson. This can significantly reduce achievement, regardless of academic ability. Your child may also feel awkward arriving to the classroom when everyone else is settled. Furthermore, when one pupil arrives late, it disrupts the entire class and the teacher - everyone's education is compromised.

Please ensure you adhere to your child's school start time. Children should not be coming into school late through the school office. They should also be picked up at their allocated time and not collected from the office early. We ask that where possible any appointments are made out of school time. If this is not possible and your child has an appointment bring a copy of your appointment letter to the office. Children coming to school late and leaving early are missing valuable learning time which can have a long-lasting impact on their progress. Thank you for your continued support.

Afterschool Activities:

Activities will start week commencing 4th March 2023 and finish week commencing 25th March 2023.

Children need to be collected after the club by an adult from the Asda entrance. If your child is attending a sporting activity, please send them to school in their school PE kit (no football strips).
